



SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINES:

The deadlines listed below apply to scholarships available quarterly.

- Summer quarter: June 1st
- Fall quarter: September 1st
- Winter quarter: December 1st
- Spring quarter: March 1st

NEED-BASED SCHOLARSHIP

CityU's Need-Based Scholarship is available each quarter and U.S. Domestic, International, and Canadian students are awarded primarily on the basis of financial need with some consideration to the written essay. The awards range from \$500 up to \$2,500 per quarter.

- **Conditions of Scholarship:**
 - Scholarship must be used for tuition only
 - Must be registered in the quarter of the scholarship award
 - Students awarded for a quarter who do not attend forfeit their scholarship
 - Students may re-apply each quarter of enrollment
 - Do not need to be in a degree-seeking program
- **Application Process:**
 - Complete **Need-Based Scholarship Application**
 - Submit up to 300 words answering the questions from the application
 - Submit 2018 Tax Assessment
 - Financial Statement

MERIT-BASED SCHOLARSHIP

CityU's Merit-Based Scholarship is available each quarter and U.S. Domestic, International and Canadian students are eligible, with an average award of \$500 up to \$2,000 per quarter.

- **Conditions of Scholarship:**
 - Scholarship must be used for tuition only
 - Must be enrolled in a degree seeking program and registered in the quarter of the scholarship award
 - Students awarded for a quarter who do not attend forfeit their scholarship
 - Students may re-apply each quarter of enrollment
 - Scholarships are not awarded to U.S. domestic candidates during the Summer quarter
 - Must have earned at least 40 undergraduate or 12 graduate credits taken at CityU until last completed quarter
 - Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 for undergraduate or 3.75 for graduate until last completed quarter
- **Application Process:**
 - Complete **Merit-Based Scholarship Application**
 - Submit up to 300 words answering the questions from the application
 - Professional resume
 - Unofficial copy of CityU transcripts

BAM SCHOLARSHIP

For our undergraduate BAM program, we have several scholarships in place for the 2019-2020 academic year. They are awarded on the basis of the individual's meeting the criteria of specific partnership agreements or special circumstances.
