### Funding options

**Only Canadian students (not international) enrolled in the Full-time program in British Columbia are eligible for full-time study provincial and federal student loans** if they qualify. Other options for financing your educational investment are:

- **Lines of credit:** many Canadian banks and chartered credit unions offer students lines of credit or loans to help you cover the cost of tuition, books and living expenses
- **Savings:** this includes the money in your bank account and investments
- **Canadian federal government CanLearn website:** grants, bursaries, and scholarships
- **Canadian government Lifelong Learning Plan (LLP):** allows you to withdraw repayable amounts from RRSPs to finance training or education.
