WHAT CAN I DO WITH MY DEGREE?

With your MEd in School Counselling degree, you will be prepared to work as a school counsellor or provide other student services in public or private schools. Because our Master's degree program meets local, regional, and provincial requirements, you will be eligible for a pay increase in the B.C. public education system.

MEd in School Counselling also meets the requirements for BC Association of Clinical Counsellors registration as a registered clinical counsellor (RCC) and Canadian Counselling Psychotherapy Association registration as a Canadian Certified Counsellor (CCC).

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher in undergraduate studies
- Complete a prerequisite course in interviewing and counselling skills or counselling theories before beginning the program
