***** Students will arrange clinical internships at local agencies or other approved settings, and deliver counselling services under the supervision of the internship site and the City U Internship Coordinator. This course serves as a vehicle for documentation of internship hours, intern evaluations, and supervisory evaluations.**

- (1) 3 Cr courses last for 8 weeks and 5 credits courses span 10 weeks
- (2) Summer intensives includes four weekend (Saturdays & Sundays: 8:30-4:45) in July only, with August and September off for Saturday cohorts only
- (3) Students can NOT challenge the following courses:
CPC 501, CPC 510, CPC 512, CPC 522, CPC 527
- (4) Students can NOT undertake ILC's for the following courses:
CPC 501, CPC 510, CPC 512, CPC 522, CPC 527
- (5) Practicum (CPC 654/655) and Research (CPC 695) cannot be undertaken until Comprehensive Exam (CPC 551) have been successfully completed.
