**Class schedule:** Classes will be held Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 9:00 - 2:00 pm and 3:00 – 8:00 pm. The Business Ethics Practicum will be held on Mondays in 3 or 4 sessions per quarter for a total of 10 hours.

\*1 Math 107 is offered for students who do not have the College Math prerequisite.

\*2 BC 401 allows to practice ethical decision making as part of a community. Each term students meet with classmates and faculty to discuss and resolve personal or professional ethical dilemmas. Over the duration of the program, they will submit: milestone artifacts including: notes from the ethics meetings; reflective journal entries, and short papers on ethical dilemmas. A total of 5 credits are earned with the portfolio - one for each quarter on a pass/fail basis. Students must obtain 5 credits to pass.

\*3 ENG 101 and 102 are offered for students who do not have the College English prerequisite.
