Over the duration of the program, they will submit milestone artifacts including: notes from the ethics meetings; reflective journal entries, and short papers on ethical dilemmas.

**Course overload eligibility is required to follow this program schedule option. Students must obtain a GPA of 2.5 or better in the first 2 quarters in order to qualify for course overload.**
